Upon the advice and authorization of the Chairman of the Conformance-Inspection Committee of the NMRA, Mr. Whitney K. Towers, we are enclosing revised Warrant number 2 in an expanded scope, now covering "All O-scale trucks and cars, both passenger and freight".

At Mr. Towers' suggestion we are withdrawing Warrant number 35, issued to All-Nations Hobby Shop on August 20, 1960; combining the items listed in that Warrant with Warrant number 2, originally issued to All Nation Hobby Shop on March 28, 1956.

May I extend my personal congratulations to the All Nation Line for consistently adhering to our Standards since the original Warrant was issued in 1956.

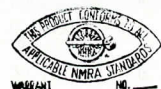

Once again it is my privilege to enclose Conformance Warrant number 2, in a re-issued and revised scope; being authorized by Mr. Whitney K. Towers, Chairman of the Conformance-Inspection Committee. 
Gentlemen:

IN MODEL RAILROAD EQUIPMENT






